AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of May 26, 2017 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An act
- 2 providing for participation in the REAL ID Act of 2005, for
- compliance by residents of this Commonwealth, for reports to
- 4 General Assembly and for publication; and repealing the REAL
- ID Nonparticipation Act," providing for exemption from fees;
- and abrogating regulations.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of May 26, 2017 (P.L.6, No.3), known as
- 10 the Pennsylvania REAL ID Compliance Act, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 3.1. Exemption from fees.</u>
- 13 (a) General rule. -- An eligible applicant who is at least 65
- 14 years of age shall be exempt from all fees related to the
- 15 administration of this act and may only be required to pay the
- 16 <u>costs of a standard-issued driver's license or photo</u>
- 17 <u>identification card.</u>
- 18 (b) Fees.--The department shall establish reasonable and
- 19 appropriate fees in order to administer this section.

- 1 Section 2. Any regulations inconsistent with this act are
- 2 abrogated to the extent of any inconsistency with this act.
- 3 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
