9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. Section 501 of the act of November 10, 1999
11	(P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code
12	Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
13	Section 501. Administration and enforcement.

15	(i) PermitsThe following apply to a permit issued for
16	construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, movement,
17	demolition or change in the occupancy of a commercial building,
18	structure or facility or to the erection, installment,
19	enlargement, alteration, repair, removal, conversion or
20	replacement of an electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system

1	regulated by the Uniform Construction Code:
2	(1) The permit holder shall keep a copy of the permit on
3	the work site until the completion of the work. A building
4	code official may require the display of the permit on the
5	work site if the display is practicable.
6	(2) If applicable, the name and address of the general
7	contractor and any subcontractor shall be disclosed in
8	writing to the building code official prior to the work being
9	performed by the general contractor or subcontractor.
10	(3) If the building code official has required the
11	display of the permit on the work site, the permit holder
12	shall also display the name of the general contractor and any
13	subcontractor disclosed to the building code official under
14	paragraph (2).
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
