L3	(a) General ruleNotwithstanding any other provision of

L7	(b) Exceptions The following shall apply:

1	(1) Individuals purchasing tickets together and
2	attending as a group shall not be subject to the social
3	distancing requirement under subsection (a) with members of
4	<u>their group.</u>
5	(2) A minor league baseball team may, at the team's sole
6	discretion, impose a social distancing requirement higher
7	than the requirement under subsection (a) as the team deems
8	necessary.
9	(c) Maximum capacityNeither the Commonwealth nor any
10	municipality may restrict the maximum capacity of a minor league
11	baseball stadium to a number lower than 50% during the COVID-19
12	<u>disaster emergency.</u>

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
