## AN ACT

- Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in conduct of elections, providing for audit of
- 3 elections.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:
- 8 <u>CHAPTER 37</u>
- 9 AUDIT OF ELECTIONS

- 11 3701. Definitions.
- 12 <u>3702</u>. Authorization.
- 13 3703. Method of audit.
- 14 <u>3704</u>. Timing of audit.
- 15 3705. Review of general election results.
- 16 3706. Penalties.
- 17 § 3701. Definitions.

- 1 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 2 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 3 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 <u>"Audit." The official inspection and review of the returns</u>
- 5 of an election in accordance with this chapter.
- 6 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
- 7 <u>"Election." A general election, municipal election, primary</u>
- 8 <u>election or special election</u>.
- 9 "General election." The election that the Constitution of
- 10 Pennsylvania requires to be held in even-numbered years.
- "Municipal election." The election that the Constitution of
- 12 Pennsylvania requires to be held in odd-numbered years.
- 13 "Primary election." An election held for the purpose of
- 14 nominating candidates for public offices to be voted for at a
- 15 general election or municipal election.
- 16 "Special election." An election authorized by law, other
- 17 than a general election, municipal election or primary election.
- 18 § 3702. Authorization.
- 19 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the department
- 20 shall conduct an audit of the results of each election to ensure
- 21 the integrity of the electoral process in this Commonwealth.
- 22 § 3703. Method of audit.
- 23 An audit shall compare the returns of an election in a county
- 24 with the information contained in the SURE system. The audit
- 25 shall:
- 26 (1) At a minimum involve a review of the first name,
- 27 <u>last name and date of birth of each elector who casts a</u>
- 28 ballot in the election.
- 29 (2) Determine whether other identifiers or signatures
- 30 are necessary to determine whether any discrepancy or

- 1 irregularity, including the casting of more than one ballot
- 2 <u>by an elector or the casting of a ballot by an unqualified</u>
- 3 elector, exists between the returns of the election and the
- 4 <u>information contained in the SURE system.</u>
- 5 (3) Reconcile the ballot of each elector who casts a
- 6 <u>ballot in the election with the historical data and other</u>
- 7 <u>information contained in the SURE system.</u>
- 8 § 3704. Timing of audit.
- 9 Not later than 90 days after an election, the department
- 10 shall conclude an audit of the election and refer any
- 11 discrepancy or irregularity to the Attorney General for further
- 12 <u>investigation and possible prosecution.</u>
- 13 § 3705. Review of general election results.
- 14 (a) Verification with neighboring states. -- Not later than
- 15 180 days after a general election, the department shall verify
- 16 with the neighboring states of this Commonwealth whether any
- 17 discrepancy or irregularity, including the casting of a ballot
- 18 in more than one state by an elector, exists regarding the
- 19 casting of ballots in the general election. The verification
- 20 shall include a review of, at a minimum, the first name, last
- 21 name and date of birth of each elector who casts a ballot in the
- 22 general election.
- 23 (b) Report. -- Not later than 30 days after the verification
- 24 under subsection (a), the department shall report the findings
- 25 of the verification to the General Assembly, along with any
- 26 recommendations to eliminate or reduce the election fraud
- 27 <u>demonstrated by the verification.</u>
- 28 § 3706. Penalties.
- 29 In addition to any other penalty prescribed by law, if an
- 30 individual casts a ballot in more than one state during the same

- 1 general election, the individual shall be quilty of a felony of
- 2 the third degree and, upon conviction thereof, shall be
- 3 sentenced:
- 4 (1) To pay a fine of not more than \$30,000 plus the
- 5 costs of investigation and prosecution of the offense.
- 6 (2) To undergo imprisonment of not more than seven
- 7 <u>years.</u>
- 8 (3) To both penalties under paragraphs (1) and (2), in
- 9 <u>the discretion of the court.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall apply to an election that occurs
- 11 on or after the effective date of this act.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
