A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for removal of municipal officers.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby resolves as follows:
5	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
6	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
7	That Article IX be amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 15. Removal of municipal officers.</u>
9	The General Assembly shall provide, by uniform general law or
10	by classification, for the removal of elected officers of a
11	municipality. Elected officers shall be removed only for cause
12	as defined by the General Assembly. Cause shall include
13	absenteeism from meetings and dereliction of duty. The
14	authorization provided by this section shall not preclude the
15	use of other provisions contained in this Constitution for the
16	disqualification, impeachment or removal of municipal officers.
17	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General

Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

8 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 9 10 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 11 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 12 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 13 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 14 15 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 16 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 17 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 18 primary, general or municipal election which meets the requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 19 20 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 21 passed by the General Assembly. 22
