## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An 1 act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and 2 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of 3 insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and 7 supervision of insurance carried by such companies, 8 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 10 repealing existing laws," in casualty insurance, further 11 providing for reimbursement for diabetic supplies. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 634(c) of the act of May 17, 1921 16 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended to read: 17 18 Section 634. Reimbursement for Diabetic Supplies. --\* \* \* 19 (C) Equipment and supplies shall include the following: 20 [blood glucose monitors, monitor supplies, insulin, injection aids, syringes, insulin infusion devices, pharmacological agents 21 for controlling blood sugar and orthotics.] 22

- 1 (1) blood glucose monitors, including continuous glucose
- 2 monitors;
- 3 (2) monitor supplies;
- 4 <u>(3) insulin;</u>
- 5 <u>(4) injection aids;</u>
- 6 <u>(5) syringes;</u>
- 7 (6) insulin infusion devices;
- 8 (7) pharmacological agents for controlling blood sugar; and
- 9 <u>(8) orthotics.</u>

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
