AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled 1 "An act relating to insurance; establishing an insurance 2 department; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law 3 relating to the licensing, qualification, regulation, 4 examination, suspension, and dissolution of insurance 5 companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-6 7 insurance exchanges, and certain societies and orders, the examination and regulation of fire insurance rating bureaus, 8 and the licensing and regulation of insurance agents and 9 brokers; the service of legal process upon foreign insurance 10 11 companies, associations or exchanges; providing penalties, and repealing existing laws," in insurance producers, further 12 providing for powers and duties of department, for 13 application for insurance producer license, for license 14 renewals and for prohibited acts. 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 17 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 602-A(b)(1), 605-A(a)(2), 608-A(a) and 18 19 611-A(19) of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as 20 The Insurance Department Act of 1921, are amended to read: 21 Section 602-A. Powers and duties of department. 2.2 * * * 23 (b) Authorizations. -- The commissioner may do all of the 24 following:
 - (1) Secure or require any documents or information,

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- including fingerprints, reasonably necessary to verify the
- 2 accuracy of information provided on an application. The
- 3 information provided under this subsection shall not be
- 4 limited by 18 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)(2) (relating to general
- 5 regulations).

- 7 Section 605-A. Application for insurance producer license.
- 8 (a) Individual application. -- An applicant with a principal
- 9 place of residence or business within this Commonwealth may
- 10 apply to the department for a resident insurance producer
- 11 license. An applicant with a principal place of residence or
- 12 business outside this Commonwealth may apply for a nonresident
- 13 insurance producer license. An applicant shall submit to the
- 14 department:

- 16 (2) the applicant's fingerprints, in order for the
- department to receive national criminal history records
- information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal
- Justice Information Services Division[;], and the information
- 20 provided under this subsection shall not be limited by 18

- 23 Section 608-A. License renewals.
- 24 (a) General rule. -- A licensee may request renewal of the
- 25 license. The licensee shall remit to the department a completed
- 26 renewal form, the required fee and verification that the
- 27 licensee has completed the continuing education required by this
- 28 act. A resident licensee that has not previously submitted
- 29 fingerprints to the department shall also submit the licensee's
- 30 fingerprints and the fee in order to permit the department to

- 1 receive national criminal history records information from the
- 2 Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal Justice Information
- 3 Services Division. Upon receipt and review, the department shall
- 4 renew the license unless it determines that the licensee is not
- 5 in compliance with this act. The information provided under this

- 10 A licensee or applicant for an insurance producer license
- 11 shall not:
