## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for qualifications of
- 3 electors.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 (1) That section 1 of Article VII be amended to read:
- 9 § 1. Qualifications of electors.
- 10 <u>(a)</u> Every citizen 21 years of age, possessing the following
- 11 qualifications, shall be entitled to vote at all elections
- 12 subject, however, to such laws requiring and regulating the
- 13 registration of electors as the General Assembly may enact.
- 14 1. He or she shall have been a citizen of the United States
- 15 at least one month.
- 16 2. He or she shall have resided in the State 90 days
- 17 immediately preceding the election.

- 1 3. He or she shall have resided in the election district
- 2 where he or she shall offer to vote at least 60 days immediately
- 3 preceding the election, except that if qualified to vote in an
- 4 election district prior to removal of residence, he or she may,
- 5 if a resident of Pennsylvania, vote in the election district
- 6 from which he or she removed his or her residence within 60 days
- 7 preceding the election.
- 8 (b) In addition to the qualifications under subsection (a)
- 9 of this section, a qualified elector shall provide a valid
- 10 identification at each election in accordance with the
- 11 following:
- 12 1. When voting in person, the qualified elector shall
- 13 present a valid identification before receiving a ballot to vote
- 14 <u>in person.</u>
- 15 2. When voting by absentee ballot or mail-in ballot, the
- 16 qualified elector shall enclose a copy of a valid identification
- 17 with his or her absentee ballot or mail-in ballot.
- 18 <u>(c) The Legislature shall, by general law, provide for the</u>
- 19 types of valid identifications necessary for a qualified elector
- 20 to comply with subsection (b) of this section.
- 21 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 22 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 23 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 24 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 25 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 26 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 27 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 28 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 29 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 30 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the

- 1 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 2 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 3 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 4 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 5 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 6 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 7 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 8 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 9 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 10 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 11 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 12 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 13 passed by the General Assembly.
