AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for
3 examination of applicant for driver's license.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1508 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 1508. Examination of applicant for driver's license.

10 (d.1) Traffic stop procedures.--

11 (1) The driver's manual shall include a section
12 outlining best practices and recommendations for a driver to
13 follow in the event the driver is stopped by a police
14 officer. The department may consult with the Pennsylvania
15 State Police, organizations that represent municipal police
16 departments, police officers or State troopers and any other
17 nonprofit entity deemed appropriate by the department that
18 focuses on traffic safety when developing the best practices

1 and recommendations required under this paragraph.

2 (2) The traffic laws examination administered by the
3 department under subsection (a) shall contain no less than
4 two questions regarding the best practices and
5 recommendations required under paragraph (1).

6 (3) Paragraph (2) shall only apply to applications made
7 under subsection (a) for Class C learner's permits or
8 driver's licenses.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
