## AN ACT

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1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and
18	prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation
19	of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of
20	certain departments, boards and commissions shall be
21	determined," in Department of Aging, providing for Federal
22	funding.
23	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
24	hereby enacts as follows:
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25	Section 1. Article XXII-A of the act of April 9, 1929
26	(P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is
27	amended by adding a section to read:
28	Section 2210.1-A. Federal FundingThe following shall

2	(1)	The	department	shall	update	the	funding	formula	required
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3 <u>under section 305(a)(2)(C) of the Older Americans Act of 1965</u>

4 (Public Law 89-73, 42 U.S.C. 3001 et seq.) consistent with

- 5 <u>Federal requirements.</u>
- 6 (2) The funding formula may not result in an area agency

7 receiving less funding than the agency received the prior fiscal

- 8 <u>year.</u>
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
