8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45),
11	known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, is amended by
12	adding sections to read:
13	Section 704. Residential building inspectors.
14	In addition to any other requirements from the department, a
15	residential building inspector shall also complete five hours of
16	continuing education in recognizing faulty construction
17	practices, including proper installation of stucco, the laws and
18	legal liability of builders in faulty construction practices and
19	the remedies available under Federal or State law for homeowners
20	in addressing faulty construction practices.

1 <u>Section 705. Providers.</u>

2	In addition to any other providers of continuing education
3	approved by the department, the Attorney General shall be
4	approved to develop and offer continuing education hours for any
5	individuals certified under this act.
6	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
