A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth 1 of Pennsylvania, in the judiciary, further providing for 2 compensation and retirement of justices, judges and justices 3 of the peace. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows: 6 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI: 8 9 That section 16(a) of Article V be amended to read: 10 § 16. Compensation and retirement of justices, judges and 11 justices of the peace. Justices, judges and justices of the peace shall be 12 compensated by the Commonwealth as provided by law. [Their 13 compensation shall not be diminished during their terms of 14 office, unless by law applying generally to all salaried 15

- 10 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 11 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 12 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 13 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 14 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 15 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 16 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 17 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 18 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 19 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 20 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 21 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 22 passed by the General Assembly.
