## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 22, 2005 (P.L.474, No.94), entitled
- 2 "An act providing for the notification of residents whose
- 3 personal information data was or may have been disclosed due
- 4 to a security system breach; and imposing penalties," further
- 5 providing for definitions.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The definition of "personal information" in
- 9 section 2 of the act of December 22, 2005 (P.L.474, No.94),
- 10 known as the Breach of Personal Information Notification Act, is
- 11 amended and the section is amended by adding definitions to
- 12 read:
- 13 Section 2. Definitions.
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 15 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 16 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 17 "Biometric information." Identifying an individual's
- 18 physiological, biological or behavioral characteristics
- 19 including an individual's deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA), that can

- 1 be used, singly or in combination with each other or with other
- 2 individually identifiable data, to establish individual
- 3 identity. Biometric information includes:
- 4 (1) imagery of the iris, retina, fingerprint, face,
- 5 <u>hand, palm, vein patterns and voice recordings that an</u>
- 6 <u>identifier template</u>, such as a faceprint, a minutiae template
- 7 <u>or a voiceprint, can be extracted;</u>
- 8 (2) keystroke patterns or rhythms;
- 9 <u>(3) gait patterns or rhythms; and</u>
- 10 (4) sleep, health or exercise data that contains
- individually identifiable information.

- 13 "Individually identifiable." Biometric information or
- 14 medical information that includes or contains an element of
- 15 personal information sufficient to allow identification of an
- 16 individual, including an individual's name, address, electronic
- 17 mail address, telephone number, Social Security number or other
- 18 information that, alone or in combination with other publicly
- 19 available information, reveals an individual's identity.

- 21 "Personal information."
- 22 (1) An individual's first name or first initial and last
- name in combination with and linked to any one or more of the
- following data elements when the data elements are not
- encrypted or redacted:
- 26 (i) Social Security number.
- 27 (ii) Driver's license number or a State
- identification card number issued in lieu of a driver's
- license.
- 30 (iii) Financial account number, credit or debit card

number, in combination with any required security code,
access code or password that would permit access to an
individual's financial account.

## (iv) Biometric information.

- (v) Medical information, including individually identifiable information, in electronic or physical form, in possession of or derived from a provider of health care, health care service plan, pharmaceutical company or contractor regarding a patient's medical history, mental or physical condition or treatment.
- 11 (2) The term does not include publicly available
  12 information that is lawfully made available to the general
  13 public from Federal, State or local government records.
