- 12 (a) Authority. -- The [department] correctional institution
- 13 and the board may contract with community organizations and
- 14 other nonprofit or for-profit entities to provide programs and
- 15 services under this chapter. The programs and services provided
- 16 under these contracts may include:

- 18 (16) Assisting incarcerated individuals in applying for
- 19 and obtaining access to public benefit programs upon release
- from incarceration and providing information about any of the
- 21 public benefit programs and assistance under section 4903(b)

- 23 (b) Accountability.--To ensure accountability, any contract
- 24 entered under this section shall contain specific performance
- 25 measures that the [department] correctional institution and the
- 26 board shall use to evaluate compliance with the terms of the
- 27 contract.
- 28 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
