AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in State Veterans' Commission and
- Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs, further
- 4 providing for definitions and providing for veterans' homes.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1701 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 1701. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Commission." The State Veterans' Commission established by
- 14 this chapter.
- 15 <u>"Community-based palliative care." Nonhospital specialized</u>
- 16 medical care for people living with a serious illness provided
- 17 through clinics, nursing and other assisted care facilities and

- 1 <u>in private homes which focuses on providing patients with relief</u>
- 2 from the symptoms and stress of the illness to improve quality
- 3 of life for both the patient and the family.
- 4 Section 2. Chapter 17 of Title 51 is amended by adding a
- 5 subchapter to read:

- 7 <u>VETERANS' HOMES</u>

- 9 <u>1741</u>. Community-based palliative care program.
- 10 § 1741. Community-based palliative care program.
- 11 <u>(a) Establishment.--The Veterans' Affairs Community-Based</u>
- 12 Palliative Care Program is established within the department.
- 13 (b) Authorization. -- The department is authorized to
- 14 <u>administer community-based palliative care services in a</u>
- 15 <u>veterans' home or with a partner in a related health care</u>
- 16 <u>facility licensed by the Department of Health for the provision</u>
- 17 of community-based palliative care services.
- 18 (c) Funding. -- The department may utilize funding
- 19 appropriated by the General Assembly for the purposes provided
- 20 <u>for under this section</u>.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
