## AN ACT

5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 5704 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
9	§ 5704. Exceptions to prohibition of interception and
10	disclosure of communications.
11	It shall not be unlawful and no prior court approval shall be
12	required under this chapter for:
13	* * *
14	(19) A person to intercept the oral communications of a
15	telemarketer, telemarketing business or an individual or
16	entity that initiates robocalls, as those terms are defined
17	in section 2 of the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911,
18	No.147), known as the Telemarketer Registration Act, provided
19	that the person who received the telephone call has consented

1	to the interception, for purposes of enforcing any of the
2	following:
3	(i) Section 3 of the Telephone Consumer Protection
4	<u>Act of 1991 (105 Stat. 2394, 47 U.S.C. § 227).</u>
5	(ii) The act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224,
6	No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer
7	Protection Law.
8	(iii) The Telemarketer Registration Act.
9	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
