## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in wiretapping and electronic 2 surveillance, further providing for exceptions to prohibition 3 of interception and disclosure of communications. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 5704 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 8 § 5704. Exceptions to prohibition of interception and 10 disclosure of communications. 11 It shall not be unlawful and no prior court approval shall be 12 required under this chapter for: \* \* \* 13 (19) A person to intercept the oral WIRE communications <--14 15 of a telemarketer, telemarketing business or an individual or 16 entity that initiates robocalls, as those terms are defined 17 in section 2 of the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911, 18 No.147), known as the Telemarketer Registration Act, provided

1 that the person who received the telephone call has consented to the interception, for purposes of enforcing any of the 2 3 following: 4 (i) Section 3 of the Telephone Consumer Protection Act of 1991 (105 Stat. 2394, 47 U.S.C. § 227). 5 6 (ii) The act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer 7 Protection Law. 8 9 (iii) The Telemarketer Registration Act. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 10
