## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for mental health instruction study.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1555. Mental Health Instruction Study.--(a) The</u>
- 13 State Board of Education shall conduct a study regarding the
- 14 manner in which instruction in mental health is offered by
- 15 school entities in this Commonwealth.
- 16 (b) In conducting the study under this section, the State
- 17 Board of Education shall request that each school entity provide
- 18 the State Board of Education with information concerning whether <--
- 19 the school entity offers instruction in mental health and the

- 1 manner in which the instruction is offered.:
- 2 (1) WHETHER THE SCHOOL ENTITY OFFERS INSTRUCTION IN MENTAL

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- 3 HEALTH.
- 4 (2) HOW MANY EMPLOYES OF THE SCHOOL ENTITY PROVIDE
- 5 INSTRUCTION IN MENTAL HEALTH.
- 6 (3) THE MANNER IN WHICH THE INSTRUCTION IN MENTAL HEALTH IS
- 7 OFFERED.
- 8 (4) ANY RESOURCES OR SUPPORT NEEDED TO IMPROVE THE PROVISION
- 9 OF INSTRUCTION IN MENTAL HEALTH.
- 10 (c) Each school entity shall provide information to the
- 11 State Board of Education in response to a request under this
- 12 <u>section</u>.
- 13 (d) The following shall apply to the report of the State
- 14 Board of Education:
- 15 <u>(1) Following the 2020-2021 school year, but not later than</u> <--
- 16 November 30, 2021 NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 30, 2023, the State <--
- 17 Board of Education shall issue a report to the following:
- 18 (i) The Governor.
- 19 (ii) The Secretary of Education.
- 20 (III) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN SERVICES.
- 21 (IV) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 22 Education Committee of the Senate.
- 23 (iv) (V) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the <--
- 24 Education Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 25 (2) The report must address the following:
- 26 <u>(i) The number of school entities offering instruction in</u>
- 27 <u>mental health.</u>
- 28 (ii) A description of the manner in which school entities
- 29 <u>are offering instruction in mental health, including the number</u>
- 30 of hours of instruction offered, the grade levels at which the

- 1 instruction is offered, the course within which the instruction
- 2 is integrated and the job title of individuals delivering
- 3 instruction.
- 4 (iii) The recommendations for improvements to the offering
- 5 <u>of instruction in mental health, including recommended</u>
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- 6 <del>legislation.</del>
- 7 (e) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 8 shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter
- 9 school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or area career
- 10 and technical school. OF INSTRUCTION IN MENTAL HEALTH.
- (E) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
- 12 SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION:
- 13 "MENTAL HEALTH." AN INDIVIDUAL'S CONDITION WITH REGARD TO
- 14 THEIR PSYCHOLOGICAL AND EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING, INCLUDING ANXIETY,
- 15 STRESS, TRAUMA OR OTHER MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL IMPAIRMENTS.
- 16 "SCHOOL ENTITY." A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHARTER SCHOOL, REGIONAL
- 17 CHARTER SCHOOL, CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL, INTERMEDIATE UNIT OR AREA
- 18 CAREER AND TECHNICAL SCHOOL.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
