## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for 1 2 injuries received by an employe in the course of employment; 3 establishing an elective schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the determination of liability and compensation thereunder; and prescribing penalties," in liability and 5 compensation, further providing for schedule of compensation. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 306(f.1)(1) of the act of June 2, 1915 11 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, is 12 amended by adding a subparagraph to read: 13 Section 306. The following schedule of compensation is 14 hereby established: 15 \* \* \* 16 (f.1) (1) \* \* \* 17 (ii.1) The following shall apply: 18 (A) In addition to the above service, the employer shall provide for reimbursement to a qualifying patient who obtains 19 medical marijuana for certified medical use under the act of 20

- 1 April 17, 2016 (P.L.84, No.16), known as the "Medical Marijuana"
- 2 Act." A qualifying patient shall:
- 3 <u>(I) be eligible for a dollar-for-dollar reimbursement on</u>
- 4 medical marijuana, for a maximum monthly reimbursement of two
- 5 <u>hundred fifty dollars (\$250);</u>
- 6 (II) cover monthly amounts in excess of two hundred fifty
- 7 dollars (\$250) that the qualifying patient spends on medical
- 8 <u>marijuana or manufactured marijuana products which shall not be</u>
- 9 <u>eligible for reimbursement under this subparagraph; and</u>
- 10 (III) be limited to a yearly maximum of three thousand
- 11 dollars (\$3,000) in reimbursements for medical marijuana.
- 12 (B) An insurer shall establish a system to reimburse
- 13 qualifying patients under this subparagraph on at least a
- 14 quarterly basis.
- (C) A patient shall be eligible for reimbursement of the fee
- 16 to obtain and renew the identification card required for a
- 17 patient to be dispensed medical marijuana under the "Medical
- 18 Marijuana Act."
- 19 (D) As used in this subparagraph:
- 20 (I) "Identification card" shall have the same meaning given
- 21 to it under section 103 of the "Medical Marijuana Act."
- 22 (II) "Medical marijuana" shall have the same meaning given
- 23 to it under section 103 of the "Medical Marijuana Act."
- 24 (III) "Patient" shall have the same meaning given to it
- 25 <u>under section 103 of the "Medical Marijuana Act."</u>

- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
