AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in bonds and
- recognizances, further providing for definitions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5741 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5741. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 10 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 11 meanings given to them in this section:
- "Bail bondsman." [A person who engages in the business of
- 13 giving bail as a surety for compensation.] A professional
- 14 <u>bondsman or a surety bondsman.</u>
- 15 "Business of giving bail" or "business of a bail bondsman."
- 16 The term includes acting as a surety for a defendant,
- 17 indemnifying a surety for a defendant or providing financial
- 18 <u>support for the release of a defendant on a monetary condition</u>
- 19 of release on bail with or without compensation to a defendant.

- 1 A person is engaged in the business of giving bail
- 2 <u>notwithstanding whether the person completes a necessary written</u>
- 3 <u>obligation required by the court of a surety or by allowing a</u>
- 4 <u>defendant for which a bond is issued to submit a necessary</u>
- 5 written obligation in the defendant's own name as surety.
- 6 "Department." The Insurance Department of the Commonwealth.
- 7 "Insurer." As defined in section 601-A of the act of May 17,
- 8 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of
- 9 1921.
- 10 "Office of the clerk." The office of the clerk of the court
- 11 of common pleas of each judicial district in which a person
- 12 engages in the business of a bail bondsman.
- 13 "Professional bondsman." <u>A person who engages in the</u>
- 14 <u>business of giving bail as a surety for compensation.</u>
- "Surety." A person who pledges security, whether or not for
- 16 compensation, in exchange for the release from custody of a
- 17 person charged with a crime prior to adjudication.
- 18 "Surety bondsman." A person who engages in the business of
- 19 giving bail as a surety without compensation in a judicial
- 20 district for at least three defendants within 30 days in
- 21 criminal proceedings not arising out of the same transaction or
- 22 <u>occurrence</u>.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
