AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), entitled 1 "An act to preserve and improve the purity of the waters of 2 the Commonwealth for the protection of public health, animal 3 and aquatic life, and for industrial consumption, and recreation; empowering and directing the creation of 5 indebtedness or the issuing of non-debt revenue bonds by political subdivisions to provide works to abate pollution; 7 providing protection of water supply and water quality; 8 providing for the jurisdiction of courts in the enforcement thereof; providing additional remedies for abating pollution 10 of waters; imposing certain penalties; repealing certain 11 acts; regulating discharges of sewage and industrial wastes; 12 regulating the operation of mines and regulating the impact 13 of mining upon water quality, supply and quantity; placing 14 responsibilities upon landowners and land occupiers and to 15 maintain primary jurisdiction over surface coal mining in 16 Pennsylvania, " in procedure and enforcement, further 17 providing for summary proceedings. 18
- 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 Section 1. Section 603 of the act of June 22, 1937
- (P.L.1987, No.394), known as The Clean Streams Law, is amended
- 23 to read:
- 24 Section 603. Summary Proceedings. -- All summary proceedings
- 25 under the provisions of this act may be commenced by the Office

- 1 of Attorney General under the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950,
- 2 No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, or brought
- 3 before any district justice of the county where the offense
- 4 occurred or the unlawful discharge of sewage, industrial waste
- 5 or pollution was maintained, or in the county where the public
- 6 is affected, [and to that end jurisdiction is hereby conferred
- 7 upon said district justices,] subject to appeal by either party
- 8 in the manner provided by law. In the case of any appeal from
- 9 any such conviction in the manner provided by law for appeals
- 10 from summary conviction, it shall be the duty of the Office of
- 11 Attorney General or the district attorney of the county to
- 12 represent the interests of the Commonwealth.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
