8	Section 1. Title 45 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
10	<u>§ 308.1. Redundant advertising on Internet by municipalities.</u>
11	(a) General ruleNotwithstanding any other law, in a case
12	where a municipality is required to advertise in a newspaper of
13	general circulation, the municipality may publish a redundant
14	advertisement on the municipality's publicly accessible Internet
15	website in addition to the newspaper advertisement.
16	(b) Effect of redundant advertisementIn the event that
17	the newspaper advertisement fails to be timely published by the
18	newspaper, the advertisement shall be valid on the date that it
19	was redundantly advertised on the municipality's publicly

1 <u>accessible Internet website.</u>

(c) Proof of publication. -- A municipality that holds a 2 meeting under a redundant advertisement shall enter in the 3 record a copy of the advertisement provided to the newspaper and 4 proof that the municipality purchased the advertisement in a 5 timely fashion. Proof shall consist of a receipt or any other 6 similar communication showing the amount paid and the date of 7 8 the purchase. 9 Section 2. Section 709 of Title 65 is amended by adding a 10 subsection to read: § 709. Public notice. 11 * * * 12 (b.1) Redundant advertising on Internet by municipalities.--13 14 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a political 15 subdivision may satisfy the public notice requirement by using a redundant advertisement in accordance with 45 Pa.C.S. § 308.1 16 (relating to redundant advertising on Internet by 17 18 municipalities). * * * 19 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
