## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), entitled "An 1 act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste 2 storage, collection, transportation, processing, treatment, 3 and disposal; requiring municipalities to submit plans for municipal waste management systems in their jurisdictions; authorizing grants to municipalities; providing regulation of the management of municipal, residual and hazardous waste; 5 6 7 requiring permits for operating hazardous waste and solid 8 9 waste storage, processing, treatment, and disposal facilities; and licenses for transportation of hazardous 10 waste; imposing duties on persons and municipalities; 11 granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the 12 Environmental Quality Board and the Department of 13 Environmental Protection to adopt rules, regulations, 14 standards and procedures; granting powers to and imposing duties upon county health departments; providing remedies; prescribing penalties; and establishing a fund," in general 15 16 17 provisions, providing for areas where landfills are 18 19 prohibited. 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 Section 1. The act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known 23 as the Solid Waste Management Act, is amended by adding a 24 section to read: Section 109. Areas where landfills are prohibited. 25
- A landfill designed, operated or maintained for the disposal

- 1 of municipal waste, residual waste or hazardous waste may not be
- 2 <u>located within 2,500 feet, measured horizontally, from an</u>
- 3 occupied dwelling. This section shall apply to a landfill
- 4 <u>seeking a permit from the department to initially open, reopen</u>
- 5 or expand operations which has not been finally granted by the
- 6 <u>department and a court having final jurisdiction</u>, as applicable.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
