AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and
- related offenses, providing for the offense of transporting
- dogs in external section of vehicle.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5538.1. Transporting dogs in external section of vehicle.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be prohibited to carry or
- 11 cause or allow to be carried a dog on the hood, roof, truck bed
- 12 or any other external section of a vehicle on a public road in
- 13 this Commonwealth.
- (b) Grading.--Upon conviction, a violation under this
- 15 <u>section shall be a summary offense punishable by:</u>
- 16 (1) A fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$150 for a
- 17 first violation.

- 1 (2) A fine of not less than \$150 nor more than \$300 for
- 2 a second violation.
- 3 (3) A fine of not less than \$300 nor more than \$500 or
- 4 <u>imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both, for a third</u>
- 5 <u>or subsequent violation.</u>
- 6 (c) Exception. -- This section shall not apply to a dog
- 7 transported in a secured insulated cage or container which is
- 8 <u>designed to facilitate the safe transportation of a dog and will</u>
- 9 prevent the dog from being exposed to outside weather conditions
- 10 and from falling, jumping or being thrown from the vehicle.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
