AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 further providing for reimbursement for certain medical
- 5 assistance items and services.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 443.6 of the act of June 13, 1967
- 9 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by
- 10 adding a subsection to read:
- 11 Section 443.6. Reimbursement for Certain Medical Assistance
- 12 Items and Services. --* * *
- 13 (h) Payment for medical assistance capitation and fee-for-
- 14 <u>service for ambulance transportation shall be as follows:</u>
- 15 <u>(1) Except as provided under paragraph (3), for basic life</u>
- 16 support, not less than three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325).
- 17 (2) Except as provided under paragraph (3), for advanced

- 1 <u>life support, not less than four hundred dollars (\$400).</u>
- 2 (3) For areas designated as super-rural by the Centers for
- 3 Medicare and Medicaid, for basic life support and advanced life
- 4 support, an additional ten percent add-on shall be added to the
- 5 rural rate for ambulance service originating in the super-rural
- 6 <u>area.</u>
- 7 (4) Notwithstanding any other law, payments made under this
- 8 <u>section shall be made in accordance with Medicare guidelines for</u>
- 9 ambulance services for the following:
- 10 (i) Each authorized medically necessary ambulance service.
- 11 (ii) Each loaded ground mileage at a rate of not less than
- 12 four dollars (\$4) for each loaded mile.
- 13 (iii) Each ambulance inflation factor.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
