13	Section 1. The act of January 10, 1968 (1967 P.L.925,
14	No.417), referred to as the Legislative Officers and Employes
15	Law, is amended by adding a section to read:
16	Section 57. (a) In addition to any other duty imposed under
17	any statute, rule, policy or guideline, the Chief Clerk of the
18	Senate, the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the
19	comptroller of the House of Representatives shall provide
20	quarterly a list of the following expenses of the Senate and
21	House of Representatives to the Legislative Data Processing
22	Center for publication on a publicly accessible Internet

2	(1) Per diems for each member of the Senate and House of
3	Representatives.
4	(2) Travel allowances and reimbursements.
5	(3) Meals and lodging.
6	(4) Equipment and furnishing control and inventory.
7	(5) District office expenses.
8	(6) Capitol office expenses.
9	(7) Official expenses.
10	(8) Special expenses.
11	(9) Miscellaneous expenses of standing and special
12	<u>committees.</u>
13	(b) The following information shall be included on the list
14	of expenses required under subsection (a):
15	(1) The member or individual for whom the expense was
16	submitted, paid and reimbursed.
17	(2) The date the expense was incurred, submitted, paid and
18	reimbursed.
19	(3) The legislative purpose for the expense.
20	(4) The account from which the expense was paid or
21	reimbursed.
22	(c) The list of expenses required under subsection (a) shall
23	be in a format that is searchable by name, office, account, date
24	and any other format authorized by:
25	(1) For the Senate, the Senate Committee on Management
