AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, No.111), entitled "An act specifically authorizing collective bargaining 2 between policemen and firemen and their public employers; 3 providing for arbitration in order to settle disputes, and 4 requiring compliance with collective bargaining agreements 5 and findings of arbitrators," providing for notice to public 6 prior to collective bargaining. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, No.111), 11 referred to as the Policemen and Firemen Collective Bargaining 12 Act, is amended by adding a section to read: 13 Section 3.1. (a) The following shall apply: 14 (1) A public employer may elect to require notice to the public prior to the beginning of collective bargaining under 15 16 section 3. The following shall apply: 17 (i) For a public employer serving a single political 18 subdivision, the governing body of the political subdivision may adopt an ordinance to require public notice under this section 19 and hold a public hearing with public comment on the forthcoming 2.0

- 1 <u>collective bargaining. The public hearing shall be held 90 days</u>
- 2 prior to the beginning of collective bargaining and shall be
- 3 publicized on the employer's publicly accessible Internet
- 4 website 14 days prior to the hearing.
- 5 (ii) For a public employer serving multiple political
- 6 <u>subdivisions</u>, the governing body that controls the public
- 7 employer, including a board or commission established by the
- 8 participating political subdivisions, may adopt a resolution to
- 9 require public notice under this section. If there is no
- 10 governing body that controls the public employer, the governing
- 11 bodies of the participating political subdivisions may all adopt
- 12 ordinances to require public notice under this section. The
- 13 governing bodies of the participating political subdivisions may
- 14 also hold hearings with public comment on the forthcoming
- 15 collective bargaining. The public hearing shall be held 90 days
- 16 prior to the beginning of collective bargaining and shall be
- 17 publicized on the employer's publicly accessible Internet
- 18 website 14 days prior to the hearing.
- 19 (2) An agency, authority or instrumentality of the
- 20 Commonwealth shall provide public notice under this section.
- 21 (b) A public employer that provides a hearing under
- 22 subsection (a) shall accept written public comments on
- 23 forthcoming collective bargaining negotiations prior to the
- 24 scheduled public hearing. The following shall apply:
- 25 (1) The written public comment period shall begin five
- 26 business days after the posting or publication under section
- 27 (1).
- 28 (2) The written public comment period shall be not less than
- 29 <u>two weeks or ten business days, whichever is longer.</u>
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
