AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled "An 1 act to promote the public health and safety by providing for 2 examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who 3 desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, 5 students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the 7 Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs of the 8 Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," 10 further providing for definitions and for fees. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding 15 16 definitions to read: 17 Section 1. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases 18 when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in 19 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 20 * * * "Mobile unit" means a self-contained, self-supporting, 21 enclosed mobile unit that meets all of the following 22

- 1 <u>requirements:</u>
- 2 (1) Is at least twenty-four feet in length.
- 3 (2) Is licensed by the board as an establishment for the
- 4 practice of cosmetology under this act.
- 5 (3) Complies with all health and safety regulations
- 6 <u>established by the board.</u>

- 8 "Salon" means a place, including a mobile unit, where the
- 9 practice of cosmetology is performed by a cosmetologist licensed
- 10 under this act.

- 12 Section 2. Section 16(b) of the act is amended to read:
- 13 Section 16. Fees.--* * *
- 14 (b) In case a salon owner changes the location of his or her
- 15 salon, other than a mobile unit, a new license must be secured.
- 16 The board shall, by regulation, fix the fee required for such
- 17 new license.

- 19 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
