AN ACT

1 Providing for allocation of money to family planning providers;
2 prohibiting certain allocation; and making an appropriation.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Short title.

6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Family
7 Planning Funding Act.

8 Section 2. Definitions.

9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
11 context clearly indicates otherwise:

12 "Department." The Department of Human Services of the
13 Commonwealth.

14 "Family planning provider." A hospital, clinic, individual
15 or other entity that is licensed to and engages in family
16 planning services.

17 "Family planning services." Diagnosis, treatment, testing,

1 pharmaceuticals, supplies, counseling and other contraceptive
2 services, including abortions, which are provided to an
3 individual of childbearing age to enable that individual to
4 prevent or end a pregnancy.

5 Section 3. Appropriation.

6 The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated to the department for
7 the purpose of this act. The department shall allocate money to
8 family planning providers in a manner that the department
9 determines maximizes the access to family planning services for
10 individuals across this Commonwealth.

11 Section 4. Discrimination prohibited.

12 The department may not discriminate against any family
13 planning provider in allocating the money under section 3 due to
14 the family planning provider providing an abortion.

15 Section 5. Money allocation prohibited.

16 An entity that identifies or formerly identified as a crisis
17 pregnancy center is prohibited from receiving money under this
18 act.

19 Section 6. Effective date.

20 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
