## AN ACT

- 1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 41606, carrying
- State Route 3011, also known as Branch Road, over Spring
- 3 Creek in Lemont, Centre County, as the Private John W. Coble
- 4 Memorial Bridge.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Private John W. Coble Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) John W. Coble was born May 6, 1912.
- 11 (2) Mr. Coble was married to Sarah Josephine Coble, and
- 12 they had six children: William Lucas Coble, Robert Harold
- Coble, Barbara Louise Coble Partner, Kay Frances Meleshenko,
- John Allan Coble and Rebecca Ann Holter.
- 15 (3) Mr. Coble entered Naval Service on May 12, 1944, and
- 16 was honorably discharged from the United States Navy on
- 17 November 18, 1945.
- 18 (4) Mr. Coble was a PennDOT employee who died while on
- 19 the job on June 19, 1972.

- 1 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 2 41606, carrying State Route 3011, also known as Branch Road,
- 3 over Spring Creek in Lemont, Centre County, is designated the
- 4 Private John W. Coble Memorial Bridge.
- 5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 7 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 8 Section 2. Effective date.
- 9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
