AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special  
3 plates for recipients of Borinqueneers Congressional Gold  
4 Medal.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1368.4. Special plates for recipients of Borinqueneers  
10 Congressional Gold Medal.

11 (a) Issuance.--Upon application of a person who is a  
12 recipient of the Borinqueneers Congressional Gold Medal,  
13 accompanied by a fee of \$22, which shall be in addition to the  
14 annual registration fee, and by any documentation that the  
15 department requires, the department shall issue to the person a  
16 special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed  
17 as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Borinqueneers  
18 Congressional Gold Medal.

19 (b) Limitation.--A special registration plate under this

1 section may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a  
2 registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

3 (c) Design.--The department shall design and produce the  
4 special registration plate under this section to display the  
5 Borinqueneers Congressional Gold Medal emblem and the words  
6 "Borinqueneers Congressional Gold Medal" at the bottom of each  
7 plate. Each special registration plate under this section that  
8 is not personalized shall also include the letter "B" as a  
9 prefix or suffix to the numerals on the special registration  
10 plate.

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
