## A RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4	Urging the Pennsylvania Department of Health to prioritize the vaccination of vulnerable populations and essential workers over legislators and other public officials who may work remotely.
5	WHEREAS, Over the course of the COVID-19 pandemic, more than
6	500,000 people in Pennsylvania have contracted COVID-19 and more
7	than 12,000 have died; and
8	WHEREAS, The development of COVID-19 vaccines and the
9	issuance of emergency use authorizations are signs of hope that
10	the COVID-19 pandemic will soon come to an end; and
11	WHEREAS, The distribution of vaccines remains a challenge and
12	health authorities must prioritize vulnerable groups and those
13	most likely to contract COVID-19; and
14	WHEREAS, Residents of long-term care facilities, health care
15	workers, teachers, service employees, staff at medical
16	facilities, transportation workers, food supply workers and many
17	others who may not be able to work from home and are regularly
18	exposed to other individuals because of their jobs or residences
19	should be prioritized for vaccination; and

1 WHEREAS, Individuals who are not at increased risk for medical complications due to COVID-19 and who can work from home 2 should not receive undue prioritization for vaccination; and 3 WHEREAS, Members of the Pennsylvania General Assembly and 4 other public officials should choose to work remotely for the 5 duration of the pandemic to avoid contracting and exposing 6 others to COVID-19 and should not accept any prioritization for 7 8 COVID-19 vaccination over others who cannot work remotely or are otherwise exposed because of their residence; therefore be it 9 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the Pennsylvania Department of Health to prioritize the vaccination 11 of vulnerable populations and essential workers over legislators 12 13 and other public officials who may work remotely.
