A RESOLUTION

Amending House Rule 53, further providing for discharge of 1 committees. 2 RESOLVED, That Rule 53 be amended to read: 3 RULE 53 4 Discharge of Committees 6 A member may present to the Chief Clerk a resolution in 7 writing to discharge a committee from the consideration of a 8 bill or resolution which has been referred to it 15 legislative days prior thereto (but only one motion may be presented for each bill or resolution). The discharge resolution shall be 10 11 placed in the custody of the Chief Clerk, who shall arrange some 12 convenient place for the signature of the members. A signature 13 may be withdrawn by a member in writing at any time before the 14 discharge resolution is entered in the Journal. When 25 members 15 of the House shall have signed the resolution, it shall be entered in the Journal and the title of the bill or resolution 16 and the name of the committee to be discharged shall be printed 17

- 1 on the calendar. Once filed, a discharge resolution shall be
- 2 <u>valid to discharge the underlying bill or resolution from any</u>
- 3 committee of the House without an additional intervening period,
- 4 not just the committee with possession of the bill or resolution
- 5 at the time of the filing.
- 6 Any member who has signed a discharge resolution which has
- 7 been on the calendar at least one legislative day prior thereto
- 8 and seeks recognition, shall be recognized for the purpose of
- 9 calling up the discharge resolution and the House shall proceed
- 10 to its consideration without intervening motion except one
- 11 motion to adjourn; however, no discharge resolution shall be
- 12 considered during the last six legislative days of any session
- 13 of the House. A majority vote of all the members elected to the
- 14 House shall be required to agree to a resolution to discharge a
- 15 committee. When any perfected discharge resolution has been
- 16 acted upon by the House and defeated it shall not be in order to
- 17 entertain during the same session of the House any other
- 18 discharge resolution from that committee of said measure, or
- 19 from any other committee of any other bill or resolution
- 20 substantially the same, relating in substance to or dealing with
- 21 the same subject matter.
