1 WHEREAS, On May 20, 2021, the Governor issued an amendment to 2 the proclamation of disaster emergency renewing the declaration; 3 and

WHEREAS, On May 18, 2021, the People of Pennsylvania adopted 4 an amendment to section 9 of Article III of the Constitution of 5 Pennsylvania which provides that orders, resolutions or votes 6 7 "to which the concurrence of both Houses may be necessary, 8 except on the questions of ... termination or extension of a 9 disaster emergency declaration as declared by an executive order 10 or proclamation, or portion of a disaster emergency declaration 11 as declared by an executive order or proclamation, shall be 12 presented to the Governor" for his approval or veto; and 13 WHEREAS, On May 18, 2021, the People of Pennsylvania adopted 14 section 20(c) of Article IV of the Constitution of Pennsylvania 15 which provides, in relevant part, "A disaster emergency 16 declaration under subsection (a) shall be in effect for no more than twenty-one (21) days, unless otherwise extended in whole or 17 18 part by concurrent resolution of the General Assembly";

RESOLVED (The Senate concurring), That the General Assembly, in accordance with section 20 of Article IV of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, hereby terminates in part and extends in part <-the disaster emergency declared on March 6, 2020, as amended and renewed, in response to COVID-19; and be it further

25 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly terminate, and not extend <--</p>
26 in part, the following portions of the disaster emergency

9 RESOLVED, That any portion of the disaster emergency-

10 declaration which is not terminated in part shall be extended in-

11 part; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That upon adoption of this concurrent resolution by 13 both chambers of the General Assembly, the Chief Clerk of the 14 House of Representatives shall notify the Governor of the 15 General Assembly's action; and be it further 16 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of 17 Representatives shall transmit this concurrent resolution to the 18 Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania
