## A RESOLUTION

Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to 1 conduct a thorough and comprehensive study on the cost of 2 implementing a safety plan for staffing of State correctional 3 institutions on Level 3 and Level 4 housing units in this 5 Commonwealth. 6 WHEREAS, Since 1954, seven corrections officers or employees at the Department of Corrections were killed in the line of duty as a result of an assault; and 8 9 WHEREAS, The most recent occurred in 2018 when a corrections 10 officer was assaulted and kicked in the head, later dying from 11 his injuries; and 12 WHEREAS, There have also been numerous major assaults 13 committed by inmates in recent years that have been directed at 14 corrections officers or employees; and 15 WHEREAS, A major assault is defined as an assault that causes 16 the victim to seek care from a medical facility outside the State correctional institution; therefore be it 17 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the 19 Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a thorough

- 2 plan for staffing of State correctional institutions on Level 3
- 3 and Level 4 housing units in this Commonwealth; and be it
- 4 further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the study determine the cost to have all Level
- 6 3 and Level 4 housing units at State correctional institutions
- 7 be staffed by at least two correctional officers per pod where
- 8 inmates are permitted freedom of movements from their cells, but
- 9 that the study not apply to any Level 3 or Level 4 housing unit
- 10 constructed within a secure bubble; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 12 submit a report to the House of Representatives containing its
- 13 findings and recommendations resulting from the study no later

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14 than August 31, <del>2022</del> 2023.
