## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for maximum gross weight of vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4941(d)(1) of Title 75 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4941. Maximum gross weight of vehicles.

- 10 (d) Natural gas <u>and electric</u> vehicles.--
- 11 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- vehicle that is operated by an engine fueled primarily by
- compressed or liquefied natural gas or powered primarily by
- 14 <u>means of electric battery power</u> may exceed the gross vehicle
- 15 weight limits imposed under this section by an amount, not to
- exceed a maximum of 2,000 pounds, that is equal to the
- difference between the weight of the vehicle attributable to
- the natural gas tank and fueling system or the battery or

- 1 <u>battery pack</u> carried by the vehicle and the weight of a
- 2 comparable diesel tank and fueling system.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
