AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of 2 controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; 3 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the 7 8 revocation or suspension of certain licenses and 9 registrations; and repealing an act," further providing for 10 prohibited acts and penalties. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 13(a) of the act of April 14, 1972 15 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, 16 Device and Cosmetic Act, is amended by adding a paragraph and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 17 18 Section 13. Prohibited Acts; Penalties. -- (a) The following acts and the causing thereof within the Commonwealth are hereby 20 prohibited: 21
- 22 (41) The operation of a clinic or establishment that

- 1 provides drug paraphernalia and space for any person to inject,
- 2 ingest, inhale or otherwise introduce into the person's body a
- 3 controlled substance in violation of this act.

- 5 (q) Any person who violates subsection (a) (41):
- 6 (1) Is quilty of a felony and upon conviction thereof shall
- 7 be sentenced to a term of imprisonment of not more than twenty
- 8 years or a fine of not more than five hundred thousand dollars
- 9 (\$500,000), or both, or a fine of two million dollars
- 10 (\$2,000,000) for a person other than an individual.
- 11 (2) Shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than two
- 12 <u>hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)</u>.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
