## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled "An act relating to the finances of the State government; 2 providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for 3 ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint 4 Underwriting Association, for entertainment business 5 financial management firms, for private dam financial 6 assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for 7 the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, 8 bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the 9 collection and recovery of fees and other money or property 10 due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 11 including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale, 12 the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds 13 and securities belonging to or in the possession of the 14 15 Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the 16 courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and 17 18 all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 19 20 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 22 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 29 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 30 31 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 32 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 34

5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known-<-

9	(a) Additional appropriations. For the 2021 2022 fiscal
10	year, from money that is received by the Commonwealth from the

16	(b) Use of money. The amount appropriated under subsection

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- 1 high-risk tasks. 2 (x) Portable, free-standing high-efficiency 3 particulate air filters. 4 (2) The design, installation, operation and maintenance 5 of heating, ventilating and air conditioning systems, 6 including air cleaning and local exhaust ventilation systems, 7 to decrease the risk of infection transmission. 8 (3) The development of emergency preparedness plans to 9 mitigate exposure to infectious aerosols and to decrease the 10 risk of infection transmission. - 7 (A) USE OF FUNDS. -- FROM MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT
- 8 FOR COVID RELIEF LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY VENTILATION GRANT
- 9 PROGRAM, \$5,000,000 SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE AUTHORITY AND
- 10 SHALL BE USED TO MAKE GRANTS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 11 (B) ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM. -- THE AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH
- 12 THE PROGRAM AS A STATEWIDE GRANT PROGRAM.
- 13 (C) PURPOSE OF PROGRAM. -- THE PROGRAM SHALL RECEIVE
- 14 APPLICATIONS AND AWARD GRANTS TO LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES IN
- 15 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 16 (D) APPLICATION. -- THE AUTHORITY SHALL DEVELOP AN APPLICATION
- 17 FOR LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES TO APPLY FOR A GRANT UNDER THIS
- 18 SECTION WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 THE APPLICATION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE AND POSTED ON THE
- 20 AUTHORITY'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE AND SHALL BE IN
- 21 A FORM THAT CAN BE COMPLETED ELECTRONICALLY OR THROUGH THE
- 22 <u>UNITED STATES MAIL.</u>
- 23 (E) DEADLINE. -- NO APPLICATION FOR A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION
- 24 MAY BE SUBMITTED 60 DAYS AFTER THE DATE THE AUTHORITY MAKES THE
- 25 APPLICATION AVAILABLE AND POSTED ON THE AUTHORITY'S PUBLICLY
- 26 ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE.
- 27 <u>(F) GUIDELINES.--THE AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH GUIDELINES</u>
- 28 THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION WITHIN
- 29 30 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION. THE GUIDELINES
- 30 SHALL BE:

6	ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT PROVIDED THAT THE FACILITY SUBMITS A PAID
7	INVOICE FOR WORK COMPLETED DURING THE DECLARED COVID-19
8	EMERGENCY OR SUBMITS A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR ANY OF THE
9	FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
10	(1) THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BEST PRACTICES REGARDING
11	INDOOR AIR MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES AIMED AT REDUCING THE RISK
12	OF TRANSMISSION OF, AND OCCUPANT EXPOSURE TO, COVID-19,
13	INCLUDING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
14	(I) DILUTION.
15	(II) AIRFLOW PATTERNS.
16	(III) OUTDOOR AIR VENTILATION.
17	(IV) PRESSURIZATION.
18	(V) DEMAND-CONTROLLED VENTILATION.
19	(VI) TEMPERATURE AND HUMIDITY DISTRIBUTION AND
20	CONTROL.

22	(VIII) ULTRA-VIOLET GERMICIDAL IRRADIATION.

25	(X) PORTABLE, FREE-STANDING HIGH-EFFICIENCY
26	PARTICULATE AIR FILTERS.
27	(XI) IONIZATION TECHNOLOGY.
28	(XII) OZONATION.
29	(2) THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE
30	OF HEATING, VENTILATING AND AIR-CONDITIONING SYSTEMS,

- 1 INCLUDING AIR-CLEANING AND LOCAL EXHAUST VENTILATION SYSTEMS,
- 2 TO DECREASE THE RISK OF INFECTION TRANSMISSION.
- 3 (3) THE DEVELOPMENT OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS TO
- 4 MITIGATE EXPOSURE TO INFECTIOUS AEROSOLS AND TO DECREASE THE
- 5 RISK OF INFECTION TRANSMISSION.
- 6 (H) GRANT LIMITS. -- THE AUTHORITY MAY AWARD A GRANT TO A
- 7 LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000.
- 8 (I) AWARD OF GRANTS. -- THE AUTHORITY SHALL AWARD GRANTS AND
- 9 MAKE GRANT PAYMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION NO LATER THAN TWO MONTHS
- 10 AFTER THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING THE GRANT APPLICATION OR 30
- 11 DAYS PRIOR TO ANY FEDERAL OR STATE IMPOSED DEADLINE ESTABLISHED
- 12 FOR THE USE OF SUCH FUNDS, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. THE AUTHORITY
- 13 SHALL ENSURE THAT GRANTS ARE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL GEOGRAPHIC
- 14 AREAS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.
- 15 (J) EXPIRATION. -- THIS SECTION SHALL EXPIRE AFTER THE MONEY
- 16 TRANSFERRED TO THE AUTHORITY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) HAS BEEN
- 17 EXHAUSTED. THE AUTHORITY SHALL TRANSMIT NOTICE OF THE DATE THAT
- 18 THE MONEY IS EXHAUSTED TO THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU FOR
- 19 PUBLICATION IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN.
- 20 (K) RETURN OF GRANTS.--IF A LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY RECEIVES
- 21 A GRANT BUT FAILS TO COMPLETE A PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSES
- 22 <u>AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (G), THE FACILITY MUST RETURN THE</u>
- 23 FUNDS TO THE AUTHORITY, WHICH WILL BE REDIRECTED TO THE GENERAL
- 24 FUND.
- 25 <u>(L) INELIGIBILITY.--A LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY THAT HAS</u>
- 26 ALREADY RECEIVED REIMBURSEMENT FOR A QUALIFYING PROJECT UNDER
- 27 <u>SUBSECTION (G,) WILL BE INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE</u>
- 28 PROGRAM.
- 29 <u>(M) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING</u>
- 30 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS

- 1 SUBSECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 2 "AUTHORITY." THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AUTHORITY.
- 3 "COVID-19." THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019, AN INFECTIOUS
- 4 <u>DISEASE CAUSED BY SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY SYNDROME CORONAVIRUS</u>
- 5 2 THAT WAS FIRST IDENTIFIED DURING DECEMBER 2019 IN WUHAN,
- 6 CHINA.
- 7 "LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES." ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (1) A LONG-TERM CARE NURSING FACILITY AS DEFINED IN
- 9 <u>SECTION 802.1 OF THE ACT OF JULY 19, 1979 (P.L.130, NO.48),</u>
- 10 KNOWN AS THE HEALTH CARE FACILITIES ACT.
- 11 (2) AN ASSISTED LIVING RESIDENCE AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 12 1001 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 13, 1967 (P.L.31, NO.21), KNOWN AS
- 13 <u>THE HUMAN SERVICES CODE.</u>
- 14 (3) A PERSONAL CARE HOME AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1001 OF
- 15 THE HUMAN SERVICES CODE.
- 16 "PROGRAM." LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY VENTILATION GRANT PROGRAM

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- 17 ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 18 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect immediately.
