## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 26, 2016 (P.L.891, No.112), entitled "An act authorizing the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to join 2 the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact; providing for the 3 form of the compact; and imposing additional powers and duties on the Governor, the Secretary of the Commonwealth and the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact," providing for criminal background checks for expedited licensure applicants. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of October 26, 2016 (P.L.891, No.112), 11 12 known as the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Act, is 13 amended by adding a section to read: 14 Section 2.1. Criminal background checks for expedited licensure 15 applicants. (a) Submission. -- For the purpose of administering the 16 17 criminal history background check required under Article V of 18 section 2 of the compact, the member board of this State shall require an applicant for an expedited license under the compact 19 to submit to a criminal history background check conducted by 20

- 1 the Pennsylvania State Police. The applicant shall submit
- 2 <u>fingerprints and other identifying information to the</u>
- 3 Pennsylvania State Police. The member board of this State shall
- 4 <u>not consider an applicant for an expedited license who refuses</u>
- 5 to comply with this subsection.
- 6 (b) Duties of Pennsylvania State Police. -- In order to assist
- 7 the member board of this State in reviewing the criminal history
- 8 background of an applicant for an expedited license, the
- 9 <u>Pennsylvania State Police or its designee shall do the</u>
- 10 <u>following:</u>
- 11 (1) Provide the member board with a report of the
- 12 <u>applicant's criminal history record information as defined in</u>
- 13 18 Pa.C.S. § 9102 (relating to definitions) or a statement
- that the Pennsylvania State Police central repository
- 15 <u>contains no information relating to the applicant. The</u>
- criminal history record information under this paragraph
- 17 shall be limited to only the information authorized to be
- disseminated under 18 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)(2) (relating to
- 19 general regulations).
- 20 (2) Submit the applicant's fingerprints to the Federal
- 21 <u>Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history</u>
- 22 records check.
- 23 (3) Provide the member board with the national criminal
- history record information of the applicant. The information
- 25 provided under this paragraph shall not be limited to only
- the information authorized to be disseminated under 18
- 27 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)(2).
- 28 (c) Use of criminal history record information. -- Criminal
- 29 <u>history record information obtained by the member board of this</u>
- 30 State under this section shall be interpreted and used only to

- 1 <u>determine an applicant's eligibility for an expedited license.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
