A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the 1 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for 2 qualifications of Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Attorney 3 General and for disqualification for offices of Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Attorney General. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6

- hereby resolves as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The following amendments to the Constitution of
- Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with Article XI: 9
- That section 5 of Article IV be amended to read: 10 (1)
- 11 § 5. Qualifications of Governor, Lieutenant Governor and
- 12 Attorney General.
- 13 No person shall be eligible to the office of Governor,
- 14 Lieutenant Governor or Attorney General except a citizen of the
- 15 United States, who shall have attained the age of 30 years, and
- 16 have been seven years next preceding his election an inhabitant
- of this Commonwealth, unless he shall have been absent on the 17
- 18 public business of the United States or of this Commonwealth. No
- person shall be eligible to the office of Attorney General 19

- 1 except [a] an active member of the bar of the Supreme Court of
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 (2) That section 6 of Article IV be amended to read:
- 4 § 6. Disqualification for offices of Governor, Lieutenant
- 5 Governor and Attorney General.
- 6 (a) No member of Congress or person holding any office
- 7 (except of attorney-at-law or in the National Guard or in a
- 8 reserve component of the armed forces of the United States)
- 9 under the United States or this Commonwealth shall exercise the
- 10 office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Attorney General.
- 11 (b) If the Attorney General is disbarred from the practice
- 12 of law in this Commonwealth, effective immediately upon the
- 13 disbarment, the Office of Attorney General shall be deemed
- 14 <u>vacant.</u>
- 15 (c) If the Attorney General is suspended from the practice
- 16 of law in this Commonwealth, effective immediately upon the
- 17 suspension, the Attorney General shall be suspended from the
- 18 Office of Attorney General and the First Deputy Attorney
- 19 General, if willing, qualified and able to hold the office,
- 20 shall serve as the acting Attorney General until the law license
- 21 of the Attorney General is reinstated or the expiration of the
- 22 term of the Attorney General, whichever is sooner. If the First_
- 23 Deputy Attorney General is not willing, qualified or able to
- 24 fill the vacancy under this subsection, the Executive Deputy
- 25 Attorney General of the Criminal Law Division, if willing,
- 26 qualified and able, shall fill the vacancy as described under
- 27 this subsection.
- 28 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 29 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the
- 30 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to

- 1 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 2 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 3 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 4 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 5 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments.
- 6 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these
- 7 proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the
- 8 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 9 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 10 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 11 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 12 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 13 these proposed constitutional amendments. The Secretary of the
- 14 Commonwealth shall submit these proposed constitutional
- 15 amendments to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the
- 16 first primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 17 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 18 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 19 three months after the proposed constitutional amendments are
- 20 passed by the General Assembly.
