## AN ACT

1 2	Requiring the acceptance of cash payments for the purchase of goods and services at retail.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Short title.
6	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Cash Payment
7	Act.
8	Section 2. Definitions.
9	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
10	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
11	context clearly indicates otherwise:
12	"At retail." A retail transaction conducted in person. The
13	term does not include a telephone, mail or Internet-based retail
14	transaction.
15	Section 3. Acceptance of cash payments.
16	A person selling or offering for sale goods or services at
17	retail shall accept legal tender when offered by a buyer as
18	payment and may not require a buyer to pay using credit or

prohibit cash or coins as payment in order to purchase the goods
 or services.

3 Section 4. Penalties.

A person that violates section 3 shall be subject to a civil 5 penalty as follows:

- 6 (1) A civil penalty of up to \$2,500 for a first offense.
  7 (2) A civil penalty of up to \$5,000 for a second or
  8 subsequent offense.
- 9 Section 5. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
