## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in charter schools, further providing 5 for funding for charter schools. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1725-A(a)(3) of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended and the subsection is amended by adding a clause to 11 12 read: Section 1725-A. Funding for Charter Schools. -- (a) Funding 13 14 for a charter school shall be provided in the following manner: \* \* \* 15 16 (3) For special education students, the charter school shall 17 receive for each student enrolled the same funding as for each 18 non-special education student as provided in clause (2), plus an 19 additional amount determined by dividing the district of

residence's total special education expenditure by [the product

- of multiplying the combined percentage of section 2509.5(k)
- 2 times the district of residence's total average daily membership
- 3 for the prior school year.] the total number of special\_
- 4 education students who reside in the school district. This
- 5 amount shall be paid by the district of residence of each
- 6 student.
- 7 (3.1) The following shall apply to clause (3):
- 8 (i) The total number of special education students who
- 9 <u>reside in the school district shall be the sum of the following:</u>
- 10 (A) The number of special education students who reside in
- 11 the school district for which the annual expenditure is in
- 12 <u>Category 1.</u>
- 13 (B) The number of special education students who reside in
- 14 the school district for which the annual expenditure is in
- 15 Category 2.
- 16 (C) The number of special education students who reside in
- 17 the school district for which the annual expenditure is in
- 18 Category 3.
- 19 (ii) The dollar ranges for the annual expenditure amounts
- 20 <u>designated as Category 1, Category 2 and Category 3 under</u>
- 21 subclause (i) and the data used to calculate the total number of
- 22 special education students who reside in the school district
- 23 under subclause (i) shall be the same as provided for under
- 24 section 2509.5(bbb)(2)(vii) and (viii).

- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
