1	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 3	Consolidated Statutes, in obstructing governmental operations, providing for the offense of evading arrest or
4	detention on foot and for the offense of harming a police
5	animal while evading arrest or detention.
6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
10	§ 5104.2. Evading arrest or detention on foot.
11	(a) Offense definedA person commits an offense if the
12	person knowingly and intentionally flees on foot from a public
13	servant attempting to lawfully arrest or detain that person.
14	(b) GradingAn offense under this section is:
15	(1) A felony of the third degree if a person flees or
16	attempts to evade arrest or detention for an underlying
17	offense that constitutes a felony or misdemeanor and another
18	person suffers serious bodily injury as a direct result of a

1 <u>violation of this section.</u>

2	(2) A felony of the second degree if a person flees or
3	attempts to evade arrest or detention for an underlying
4	offense that constitutes a felony or misdemeanor and another
5	person suffers death as a direct result of a violation of
6	this section.
7	(3) Except as provided under paragraph (1) or (2), a
8	misdemeanor of the second degree if a person flees or
9	attempts to evade arrest or detention for an underlying
10	offense that constitutes a felony or misdemeanor.
11	(4) Except as provided under paragraph (1), (2) or (3),
12	<u>a summary offense.</u>
13	<u>§ 5104.3. Harming a police animal while evading arrest or</u>
14	detention.
15	(a) Offense definedA person commits an offense if, while
16	engaging in an act prohibited under section 5104 (relating to
17	resisting arrest or other law enforcement), 5104.1 (relating to
18	disarming law enforcement officer) or 5104.2 (relating to
19	evading arrest or detention on foot) OR 75 PA.C.S. § 3733 <
20	(RELATING TO FLEEING OR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE POLICE OFFICER), the
21	person harms a police animal as defined in section 5531
22	(relating to definitions).
23	(b) GradingAn offense under this section is:
24	(1) A felony of the third degree if the police animal
25	suffers death or serious bodily injury.
26	(2) A misdemeanor of the second degree if the police
27	animal suffers bodily injury.
28	(C) RESTITUTIONIN A CASE IN WHICH A DEFENDANT IS <
29	CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION UNDER SUBSECTION (A), THE DEFENDANT
