## AN ACT

Designating the portion of State Route 2004, also known as North 1 Broad Street, within the Borough of Lansdale AND HATFIELD 2 TOWNSHIP, Montgomery County, as the Dr. Frank Erdman Boston Memorial Highway. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Dr. Frank Erdman Boston Memorial Highway. 8 Findings. -- The General Assembly finds as follows: 9 (1)Frank Erdman Boston was born March 10, 1891, in 10 Philadelphia and later attended Lincoln University, 11 originally established as The Ashmun Institute, the nation's 12 first degree-granting Historically Black College and 13 University. Frank Boston then attended the Medico-Chirurgical 14 15 College, an outgrowth of the Medico-Chirurgical Society of 16 Philadelphia, which merged with the University of Pennsylvania Medical College and Jefferson Medical College. 17

(3) Dr. Boston enlisted and was immediately given the

- 1 rank of first lieutenant in the Army Medical Reserve Corps,
- where he served in France during World War I with the rank of
- 3 captain and ended his military service as a major.
- 4 (4) After the war, Dr. Boston returned to work in
- 5 Philadelphia and later settled in Lansdale where he opened
- 6 the Elm Terrace Hospital, which was later renamed North Penn
- 7 Hospital and subsequently became part of the Abington-
- 8 Jefferson Health Systems.
- 9 (5) Dr. Boston also formed a First Aid Emergency Squad
- in Lansdale, eventually known as the Volunteer Medical
- 11 Service Corps of Lansdale, and was a member of the Reserve
- Officers Association of Military Surgeons, the Montgomery
- 13 County Medical Society and the American Medical Association.
- 14 (6) Dr. Boston died February 8, 1960, at 69 years of
- 15 age, and was buried in Lansdale.
- 16 (b) Designation. -- The portion of State Route 2004, also
- 17 known as North Broad Street, within the Borough of Lansdale AND <--
- 18 HATFIELD TOWNSHIP, Montgomery County, is designated as the Dr.
- 19 Frank Erdman Boston Memorial Highway.
- 20 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 21 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 22 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 23 Section 2. Effective date.
- 24 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
