## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for Safe Exchange Zone
- 3 Program.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 16 This chapter relates to the Safe Exchange Zone Program.
- 17 § 6202. Definitions.

- 1 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 2 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 3 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 "County." A county of any class.
- 5 <u>"Department." The Department of Community and Economic</u>
- 6 <u>Development of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 7 "Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town,
- 8 township or home rule, optional plan or optional charter
- 9 <u>municipality or municipal authority in this Commonwealth and any</u>
- 10 entity formed under Subchapter A of Chapter 23 (relating to
- 11 <u>intergovernmental cooperation</u>).
- 12 "Participant." An individual utilizing a safe exchange zone.
- 13 "Participating entity." A local police department, a county
- 14 sheriff or the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 15 "Program." The Safe Exchange Zone Program established under
- 16 <u>section 6204(a) (relating to Safe Exchange Zone Program).</u>
- 17 "Safe exchange zone." A place which meets the requirements
- 18 under section 6204(e)(1)(iii).
- 19 § 6203. Legislative purpose.
- The purpose of this chapter is to establish safe public
- 21 locations for participants to exchange goods purchased online
- 22 and for child custody exchanges through the distribution of
- 23 grant money to municipalities.
- 24 § 6204. Safe Exchange Zone Program.
- 25 (a) Establishment. -- The Safe Exchange Zone Program is
- 26 <u>established within the department.</u>
- 27 (b) Eligibility. -- Municipalities may apply for a grant under
- 28 the program to establish safe exchange zones at a participating
- 29 <u>entity's office or barracks or in a public area.</u>
- 30 <u>(c) Application.--The department shall generate an</u>

- application upon which municipalities may apply for a grant 1 under the program. The form shall indicate the cost of 2 establishing a safe exchange zone, the location, the approval of a participating entity to assist with the safe exchange zone and 4 any additional information the department deems necessary. 5 (d) Duty of department. -- The department shall approve or 6 7 deny an application under subsection (b) within 30 days of receipt of the application. Upon approval of an application, the 8 department shall disburse the grant money as provided under 9 10 subsection (h). 11 (e) Safe exchange zone requirements and assignment of 12 responsibility. --13 (1) Safe exchange zones: 14 (i) Shall have an appropriate video surveillance system to observe all areas of the safe exchange zone, 15 16 which shall be monitored by a participating entity. (ii) Shall be clearly indicated with proper signage 17 18 that displays the participating entity's telephone number 19 and "in case of an emergency dial 911." 20 (iii) May only be placed: 21 (A) Within 100 feet of a local police 22 department's office. 23 (B) Within 100 feet of a county sheriff's 24 office. 25 (C) Within 100 feet of a State Trooper barracks. 26 (D) Within 100 feet of a public park, county 27 courthouse, local magistrate's office, municipal office or other public area that has an active public 28
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presence, as approved by the department.

(iv) Must be on public land.

- 5 participating entities, the department shall establish
- 6 guidelines and procedures for the adequate monitoring of video
- 7 <u>surveillance required under subsection (f)(1) and for</u>
- 8 <u>surveillance measures necessary to keep participants and the</u>
- 9 public safe, which do not infringe on the Fourth Amendment
- 10 rights of the participants of the exchange provided for in the
- 11 Constitution of the United States.
- (h) Priority of award. -- Priority shall be given to
- 13 municipalities awarded a grant under this section in the
- 14 <u>following order:</u>
- 15 <u>(1) Municipalities seeking to establish safe exchange</u>
- zones within 100 feet of a local police department, county
- sheriff's office or State Trooper barrack.
- 18 (2) Municipalities seeking to establish safe exchange
- 19 zones in a public area.
- 20 (i) Disbursement of money. -- The Secretary of Community and
- 21 Economic Development shall ensure that the grant money awarded
- 22 under this section is geographically disbursed throughout this
- 23 Commonwealth.
- 24 (j) Use and audit. -- Grant money must be used exclusively for
- 25 the purpose of establishing a safe exchange zone and is subject
- 26 to audit by the department and the Auditor General.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
