AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in speed restrictions, further providing for
- driving vehicle at safe speed and for charging speed
- 4 violations.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 3361 and 3366 of Title 75 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 3361. Driving vehicle at safe speed.
- 10 The following shall apply:
- 11 <u>(1)</u> No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed greater
- than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions and
- 13 having regard to the actual and potential hazards then
- existing, nor at a speed greater than will permit the driver
- 15 to bring his vehicle to a stop within the assured clear
- distance ahead. Consistent with the foregoing, every person
- shall drive at a safe and appropriate speed when approaching
- and crossing an intersection or railroad grade crossing, when
- approaching and going around a curve, when approaching a hill

- 1 crest, when traveling upon any narrow or winding roadway and
- when special hazards exist with respect to pedestrians or
- 3 other traffic or by reason of weather or highway conditions.
- 4 (2) A driver shall not be presumed to have violated this
- 5 <u>section based solely on the occurrence of an accident. A full</u>
- 6 <u>investigation into an accident where a violation of this</u>
- 7 <u>section is suspected as a cause shall be conducted to</u>
- 8 <u>determine a driver's alleged speed.</u>
- 9 § 3366. Charging speed violations.
- 10 In every charge of violation of a speed provision in this
- 11 subchapter, [except for a violation of section 3361 (relating to
- 12 driving vehicle at safe speed),] the citation or complaint shall
- 13 specify the speed at which the defendant is alleged to have
- 14 driven and the applicable speed limit.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
