## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 3 4 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing 5 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 6 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in tax for education, further providing for 10 11 crimes. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 268(b) of the act of March 4, 1971 15 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended 16 by adding a paragraph to read: Section 268. Crimes. -- \* \* \* 17 (b) Other Crimes. \* \* \* 18 19 (4) Nothing under this subsection shall prohibit an 20 advertisement which includes the amount of the tax imposed under 21 this article in the advertised price as long as the 22 advertisement conspicuously states that the advertised price
- 23 includes the amount of the tax imposed under this article.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
