AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the Student Loan Forgiveness Program for Nurses
- and Nurse Faculty; and imposing duties on the Pennsylvania
- 3 Higher Education Assistance Agency.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Student Loan
- 8 Forgiveness Program for Nurses and Nurse Faculty Act.
- 9 Section 2. Declaration of purpose.
- 10 The General Assembly declares that the purpose of this act is
- 11 to provide an incentive for individuals to pursue training in
- 12 nursing or training to become nurse faculty and remain in this
- 13 Commonwealth to live and work in nursing.
- 14 Section 3. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 16 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 18 "Agency." The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance

- 1 Agency.
- 2 "Nurse faculty." A registered nurse with at least one year
- 3 of clinical experience in nursing who possesses an advanced
- 4 degree in nursing from an accredited college or university
- 5 located in this Commonwealth and is employed as full-time or
- 6 part-time faculty teaching in a field of nursing education in
- 7 this Commonwealth.
- 8 "Program." The Student Loan Forgiveness Program for Nurses
- 9 and Nurse Faculty established under section 4(a).
- "Qualified health care facility." Any of the following
- 11 facilities:
- 12 (1) An assisted living residence.
- 13 (2) A home care agency.
- 14 (3) A home health care agency.
- 15 (4) A hospice agency.
- 16 (5) A hospital.
- 17 (6) A Living Independence for the Elderly (LIFE)
- 18 program.
- 19 (7) A long-term care facility.
- 20 (8) A personal care home.
- 21 "Recipient." An individual who receives student loan
- 22 forgiveness under the program.
- 23 Section 4. Student Loan Forgiveness Program for Nurses and
- Nurse Faculty.
- 25 (a) Establishment. -- The Student Loan Forgiveness Program for
- 26 Nurses and Nurse Faculty is established in the agency.
- 27 (b) Administration. -- The agency shall administer the program
- 28 for the purpose of providing student loan forgiveness for
- 29 eligible individuals who enter into an agreement with the agency
- 30 as provided under subsection (d).

- 1 (c) Qualifications. -- To qualify for the program, an
- 2 applicant must meet all of the following criteria:
- 3 (1) Be employed as a registered nurse, certified
- 4 registered nurse practitioner or clinical nurse specialist.
- 5 (2) Be a resident of this Commonwealth.
- 6 (3) Hold an undergraduate academic degree, graduate
- 7 level academic degree or doctoral academic degree from an
- 8 accredited college or university located in this
- 9 Commonwealth.
- 10 (4) Have been hired as a full-time employee of a
- 11 qualified health care facility in this Commonwealth.
- 12 (5) Have successfully completed at least the first year
- of full-time employment as an employee of a qualified health
- 14 care facility in this Commonwealth.
- 15 (d) Loan forgiveness. -- The agency shall forgive up to
- 16 \$1,000,000 annually in student loans for recipients. Recipients
- 17 who are not nurse faculty must enter into an agreement with the
- 18 agency to be employed at a qualified health care facility in
- 19 this Commonwealth for a period of five years. Recipients who are
- 20 nurse faculty must enter into an agreement with the agency to be
- 21 employed full time or part time at an accredited college or
- 22 university located in this Commonwealth for a period of five
- 23 years. Annual recipients shall include at least one individual
- 24 from each of the following regions of the Commonwealth:
- 25 (1) Northwest Region composed of Cameron, Clarion,
- 26 Clearfield, Crawford, Elk, Erie, Forest, Jefferson, Lawrence,
- 27 McKean, Mercer, Venango and Warren Counties.
- 28 (2) Southwest Region composed of Allegheny, Armstrong,
- 29 Beaver, Butler, Cambria, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Somerset,
- 30 Washington and Westmoreland Counties.

- 1 (3) Northcentral Region composed of Bradford, Centre,
- 2 Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Montour, Northumberland, Potter,
- 3 Snyder, Sullivan, Tioga and Union Counties.
- 4 (4) Southcentral Region composed of Adams, Bedford,
- 5 Blair, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Huntingdon,
- 6 Juniata, Lebanon, Mifflin, Perry and York Counties.
- 7 (5) Northeast Region composed of Carbon, Lackawanna,
- 8 Lehigh, Luzerne, Monroe, Northampton, Pike, Susquehanna,
- 9 Wayne and Wyoming Counties.
- 10 (6) Southeast Region composed of Bucks, Berks, Chester,
- Delaware, Lancaster, Montgomery, Philadelphia and Schuylkill
- 12 Counties.
- 13 (e) Agreement provisions. -- The agreement under subsection
- 14 (d) shall include the following terms:
- 15 (1) A recipient who is not nurse faculty shall agree to
- be employed at a qualified health care facility in this
- 17 Commonwealth for a combined total of no less than five years.
- 18 (2) A recipient who is nurse faculty shall agree to be
- 19 employed at an accredited college or university located in
- 20 this Commonwealth for a combined total of no less than five
- 21 years.
- 22 (3) The recipient shall permit the agency to determine
- 23 compliance with the work requirement and all other terms of
- the contract.
- 25 (4) Upon the recipient's death or permanent disability,
- the agency shall not be required to provide student loan
- forgiveness under the program.
- 28 (5) The agency may terminate student loan forgiveness
- and demand repayment of the amount of student loans forgiven
- 30 if:

- 1 (i) the recipient is convicted of or pleads guilty
 2 or no contest to a felony; or
- (ii) the State Board of Nursing has determined that
 the recipient has committed an act of gross negligence in
 the practice of nursing or has suspended or revoked the
 recipient's license to practice.
- 7 (6) A recipient who fails to begin or complete the 8 obligations contracted for shall pay to the agency the amount 9 of the loan received under the terms of the contract.
- 10 Providing false information or misrepresentation on an
- 11 application or verification of service shall be deemed a
- default. Determination as to the time of the default shall be
- made by the agency. The recipient and the agency shall make
- every effort to resolve conflicts to prevent a breach of the
- 15 agreement.
- 16 (f) Agreement enforcement. -- Notwithstanding 42 Pa.C.S. §
- 17 8127 (relating to personal earnings exempt from process), the
- 18 agency may seek garnishment of wages of a recipient who fails to
- 19 comply with the agreement under subsection (d) for the amount of
- 20 student loan forgiveness provided to the recipient.
- 21 Section 5. Tax applicability.
- 22 Student loan forgiveness received under this act shall not be
- 23 considered taxable income for purposes of Article III of the act
- 24 of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of
- 25 1971.
- 26 Section 6. Funding.
- 27 Student loan forgiveness payments under this act shall be
- 28 made only to the extent that funds are appropriated for the
- 29 program and are sufficient to cover administration of the
- 30 program. Student loan forgiveness under this act shall not

- 1 constitute an entitlement derived from the Commonwealth or a
- 2 claim on any funds of the Commonwealth.
- 3 Section 7. Regulations.
- 4 The agency shall promulgate regulations necessary to
- 5 administer this act.
- 6 Section 8. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
