13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
16	as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a
17	section to read:
18	Section 107. Public Funding of Elections(a) The cost and
19	expense to State and local governments relating to the
20	registration of voters and the preparation, administration and
21	conduct of elections in this Commonwealth shall be funded only

1	upon lawful appropriation of the Federal, State and local
2	governments, and the source of funding shall be limited to money
3	derived from taxes, fees and other sources of public revenue.
4	(b) State and local governments, including their public
5	officers, public officials, employees and agents, may not
6	solicit, apply for, enter into a contract for or receive or
7	expend gifts, donations, grants or funding from any individual,
8	business, organization, trust, foundation, or any
9	nongovernmental entity for the registration of voters or the
10	preparation, administration or conducting of an election in this
11	Commonwealth.
12	(c) This section shall not be construed to apply to the
13	collection of fees authorized by law or to the donation or use
14	<u>of:</u>
15	(1) a location for voting purposes;
16	(2) services that are provided without remuneration; or
17	(3) goods that have a nominal value of less than one hundred
18	<u>(\$100) dollars.</u>
19	(d) A person who violates this section commits a felony of
20	the second degree.
21	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 90 days. <

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
