9	Section 1. Section 5803(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
10	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
11	§ 5803. Asset forfeiture.
12	(a) ApplicabilityNotwithstanding any law to the contrary,
13	this section shall apply to forfeitures conducted under the
14	following:

19	Section 2. Section 7721 of Title 75 is amended to read:
20	§ 7721. Operation on streets and highways.

1 (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in this 2 chapter, it is unlawful to operate a snowmobile, <u>dirt bike</u> or an 3 ATV on any street or highway which is not designated and posted 4 as a snowmobile, <u>dirt bike</u> or an ATV road by the governmental 5 agency having jurisdiction.

6 (b) Emergency and bridge crossings.--A snowmobile, dirt bike
7 or an ATV may be operated on highways and streets:

8 (1) During periods of emergency when so declared by a 9 policy agency having jurisdiction.

10 (2) When necessary to cross a bridge or culvert.
11 (c) Crossing street or highway.--A snowmobile, dirt bike or
12 an ATV may make a direct crossing of a street or highway upon
13 compliance with the following requirements:

14 (1) The crossing is made at an angle of approximately 90
15 degrees to the direction of the highway and at a place where
16 no obstruction prevents a quick and safe crossing.

17 (2) The snowmobile, dirt bike or ATV is brought to a
18 complete stop before crossing the shoulder or main-traveled
19 way of the highway.

20 (3) The driver yields the right-of-way to all oncoming
21 traffic which constitutes an immediate hazard.

(4) In crossing a divided highway, the crossing is made
only at an intersection of such highway with another public
street or highway.

25 (d) Penalties.--A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (E), A <--
 26 dirt bike or all-terrain vehicle operated on any public street,
 27 highway or right-of-way in a city of the FIRST CLASS, SECOND <--
 28 CLASS, SECOND CLASS A OR third class or a borough in violation

29 of this section shall be designated as prima facie contraband

30 subject to forfeiture in accordance with 42 Pa.C.S. § 5803

15	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
